"At NC 8322 3208, set on a south-facing hill slope, there is a burnt mound. It is sub-oval, measuring 9.0m E-W by 8.0m with a height of about 0.9m. A trial dig in the mound revealed a content of blackened earth and small, friablestones. Although the mound is not unlike some of the clearance heaps in the area, its content is quite different. The mound lies immediately to the south of a settlement (HNC 83 SW 003), and some 20.0m west of a water course." (OSFI:JB:1.3.1977).
