"This circular mound overgrown with grass lies at the edge of a field at about 150 ft OD. The diameter is about 36 ft and the height is about 3 ft 6 in. Near the centre there protrudes the top of a large slab 2 ft 8 in long, 1 ft 2 in thick and 1 ft 6 in high, which suggests that this may be a chambered cairn." (2).

"Cairn. 'Westfield'. Dimensions: 20.10m x 19m. Height: Im. Circular grass-covered mound with two orthostats set at right angles to each other in the centre of the circle. Orientation: N-S." ND 057636." (6).

"This grass-covered cairn measures 23.0m NE-SW by 19.0m transversely, and is 1.7m high. Several large stones are evident in the top, but there is no conclusive evidence of a chamber." (OSFI:RD:2.11.1964).
