Rectangular building, 16.4m x 4.4m (external) Offset "cell" - 3.5 x 3.7m
 A low tumble of stones defines the walls of this structure, on the west 0.5m high in about six courses. Other side survives as low turf covered bank with some stone visible. Remains turf covered "cell" at NE corner. Two entrances in western wall with small partition visible internally towards northern end. Oriented N-S.
