"Chambered Cairn (supposed), Hempriggs: Evidenced by a low grassy mound, stony beneath the turf, which has a diameter of some 50 ft and an elevation of 3 to 4 ft. Near the centre two large slabs at right angles to each other suggest this may be the remains of a chambered cairn, but the true character of the mound is not obvious." (2).

"A low, turf-covered, stony mound which has been greatly robbed, and, as described by the RCAHM could be the remains of a chambered cairn." (3).

"ND 3617 4680. Cairn. Hempriggs. Dimensions, 15.25m diameter, height 0.9 - 1.2m. Low grassy mound with two large slabs at right angles, ?chambered cairn.
