To Mrs. G. Duff Dunbar of Hempriggs and G. A. Duff of Hatton, Trustees of the late Garden Duff-Dunbar of Hempriggs, per D. W. Georgeson, Esq., Commissioner, Wick, the owner of the Monument known as Cairn situated 610 yards south-south-east of Barns of Hempriggs, 630 yards east-south-east of Hempriggs Mains, and 200 yards west of the coast at its nearest point near Helmer Head being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Hempriggs Farm

situated in the Parish of Wick, and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

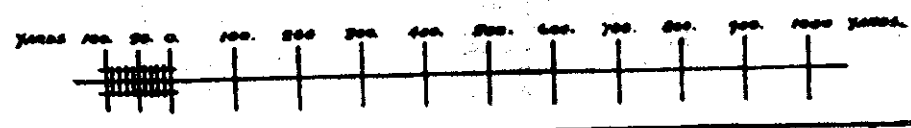
