"Mr MacLeod, the shoemaker, of Clachan, Raasay, has in his possession a LBA rivetted and socketed bronze spearhead, given to him by a crofter who found it about 1916 in a natural rock shelter beneath the cliffs at Eyre Point. The blade is 8 " (203mm) long and 1 1/2 " (43mm) across the broadest part. Part of the socket is missing." (OSFI:ASP:14.6.1961).
