'At NH 6383 2931 set into a S-facing slope is a circular stone-walled hut measuring c.10.0m in diameter between the centres of a wall spread to 2.5m. The ill-defined entrance is in the SE and is flanked by an upright stone in the NE. The hut floor is partly occupied by a scatter of stones.

'The hut occurs on the S edge of a contemporary field system marked by stone clearance heaps, lynchets, and occasional ruinous walls, with occasional cultivation plots visible averaging 30.0m x 15.0m. Huts surveyed at 1:2500. Extent of field system on 1:10 000 sheet.
