I refer to your consultation in connection with the above subjects and now write to confirm that there are no scheduled ancient monuments which are protected at a national statutory level within the study area.

However, there are two unscheduled sites of archaeological interest which lie within the study area:-

1. Achlaschoille, field system NH 697 375, centred at NH 697 375.
2. Black Wood of Leys, cairns: cists NH 689 379, centred at NH 689 379.
