 "A very large stone axe found at Drakies, near Inverness, together with a stone cup or patera found in the same place, was presented to Inverness Museum before 1827. The axe is in Case B of the Large Room in the Museum. (Se HNH 64 SE 019 for another axe found at Drakies)." (1)(2)
 In Inverness is a large polished stone axe from Inshes. As Inshes and Drakies are adjoining states it is probable that this is one and the same axe." (OSFI:JLD:23.3.1962)
