Dear Mr Fraser,

Robert Gourlay has passed to us a fragment of leather which you found at (or in) a mound of stones.

I'm afraid that the item isn't really big or distinctive enough for us to be able to say very much about it; it looks like an off-cut strip, but without spending £430 on a radiocarbon date on it, we cannot say how old it is.

Given the uncertainties over this item, it would not be appropriate to process it as a Treasure Trove case. I think, however, that it is worth having a record of the mound of stones in the local Sites and Monuments Record, and if you were willing to leave the leather strip in the care of a local museum (e.g. Inverness), then it would be available for study in the future.

Please let me know what you feel about this.

I am sorry that I cannot be more specific about identifying the object.
