"NH 6097 7230 Hut Circle."(1) "At Nh 6097 7230 on a NE slope is a ruinous stone-walled hut visible as a platform measuring c11.0m NE-SW by c9.5m transversely, with traces of a stone-wall around the N half. The SW arc, visible as a slight scarp, is mutilated by a tract. The ill-defined entrance is in the NE. The hut is crossed by a fence. To the S is an area of stone clearance heaps probably from contemporary cultivation plots. Isolated from this area by a boggy gully and centred at Nh 611 718 is a smaller area of clearance heaps, also probably contemporary with the hut."(OSFI:AA:10.11.1970)
