Romano-British trumpet brooch in poor condition, with pin, catch plate, ?solid chain loop & foot missing. Head decorated with rosette, with no indication of enamelling. Worn midbow button defined by 2 grooves. Chevron decoration on bow. Cast lug mounting for hinge below trumpet. L: 39mm.
