 Trumpet brooch found with metal detector in plough soil. length 45mm. Characteristic Romano-British Trumpet brooch of earlier-second century date. This example is a small and cheaper cast piece with cast chain loop (missing) and hinged pin. The mid-bow moulding is of crude acanthus type, with moulding only on front face. The foot knob and base of catch plate are missing. Decorated with Celtic swirling blue enamelled mouldings.
