

Description. The site is in the middle of a field in the undulating agricultural land of the valley floor, at 700ft. OD. It appears to have been built on a slight knoll. The cairn has been so greatly robbed that little cairn material remains, and the interior is now grass-grown. However, the greater part of the kerb remains though with numerous gaps where stones have been removed. The diameter is about 45 ft. It is built of rounded boulders, rather larger and more regular on the s and w side though they are not systematically graduated. Some of these stones are leaning at an angle into the cairn area; the tallest is exposed to a height of 2 ft. 9 in. Outside the kerb there is a considerable bank of cairn material. There are five stones, apparently earthfast, in the centre of the cairn, but some of these must be displaced. The tallest projects for 1 ft. 2 in.

On the NE side of the site, 16ft. from the kerb, is the stump of what has probably been a monolith. Another fallen stone at a similar distance from the kerb on the N side may be part of another monolith.

The site was not quite so ruined when seen by Grant, for he records 'the outer circle is completely gone with the exception of three roundish blocks, which have been rolled in upon the inner circles, in order to be out of the way of the plough. The inner circles are 42ft. and 12ft. in diameter, but without many small stones in the space between them."
