TEXT

a) Site Description:

Lochaline House was originally a 20-bedroomed regency mansion house erected in 1821 by John Sinclair. In the 1870s it was considerably enlarged by Margaret Paterson (who "cleared" approximately 150 smallholders off the estate to make way for sheep grazings) who erected the ornate italianate central tower and facade. In 1910 it was deliberately set on fire, destroying the original building and leaving the facade virtually freestanding. Since then it has deteriorated significantly and is now in a dangerous condition. It stands in 12 acres of well wooded policies. It is not listed.
