 "In the area centred at NN 674912, on a slope overlooking the RIVER TRUIM there are the remains of the settlement of Crubinmore, depopulated circa 1847, and consisting of the grass-covered footings of about eleven buildings varying in size from 24.5m x 5.0m to 6.0m x 3.0m, two corn drying kilns and five small enclosures. An old track runs along the W side of the site, and all around there is evidence of field clearance." (OSFI:RC:1.10.1986) "NN 674 912 'Unroofed buildings, enclosures \* field walls.'" (1)
