

NB91SE0003 An Dun, Reiff

Notes

1. I'd suggest the above title.
2. The text simply gives "place-name" as the evidence. Unfortunately, the 1973 and later OS 1: 25 000 maps put the words "An Dun" well back from the shore above Reiff, inconsistently with the grid ref 9655 1436. Earlier maps (with the previous grid) put the words on the shore at the point the current grid ref indicates.
3. It appears to be an entirely natural rock formation. No loose stones of any kind are exposed on the upper parts, i.e. there is no obvious sign of any human addition to the natural rock, recent or ancient.
