

BURIAL CAIRN - KISHORN

This Neolithic? burial cairn is 11.5m in diameter x 1m high. Some of the large base stones are still visible around its circumference. The top has been removed in antiquity (probably to construct a field boundary wall that lies adjacent to it), to reveal a stone lined cist orientated NNE-SSW. This cist is 1.3m long x 0.9m wide and currently filled with soil such that only the top few inches shows.
