The Basin lies to the east of the B8007 road that runs down to Camas nan Geall from the Kilchoan side. Much of this open area shows signs of agricultural workings, but there are also a number of stone walls and buildings which suggest that it may have been settled. The present road follows one track which ran down the west side, a second trackway is still visible along the eastern side.
