473677.01 Cairn at 4739167635, 3m x 2.7m. Cairn by side of Estate fence. Rocks, <40cm, robbed for fence. Built against natural rock exposure.

473677.03 Cairn at 4742967621. 2m x 1.5m, built against rock outcrop.

473677.04 Cairn at 4744567619. A lozenge-shaped pile of loose rocks surrounded by isolated rocks covering an area of 50sq m, out in open. Long axis 095°.

473677.05 Cairn at 4744867637. 3m x 1.3m. Long axis 030°.

473677.06 Cairn at 4747567619. 3.3m x 2.5, 1m high cairn formed of rocks <50cm.

473677.07 Cairn at 4750767639. 5.7m x 5m, formed of rocks <30cm, built against large rock, long axis 230deg.
