This area is the site of many hundreds of years of settlement, with structures and fields scattered across the landscape. Bald's 1806 map marks it as part of the Achateny clachan, with fields on both sides of the Fascadale burn.

498705.01 At 4974970400 to the SE of Fascadale, a cairn of large boulders on top of a knoll, with views north across the sea. Possible burial cairn or marker.

498705.02 On the E side of, and close to the burn, a wall with evidence of a hut, byre or dwelling. The wall, which encloses an area of land using the river as the W boundary, is in good condition, with turfs along the top of some sections. Wall was probably an animal gathering enclosure.
