A circle of stones, diameter ~12m, on a low knoll looking down the valley of the Allt Choire Mhuilinn towards Mingary. Dr Oliver Harris of the University of Leicester has looked at it and believes it to be either a kerb cairn or the circle of a Bronze Age hut. There is no sign of a cist grave within the circle, but this may well lie hidden beneath the soil.
