Walls of a possible dwelling house, with entrance in south wall which trends east-west. There is a porch-like structure in front of the door. House stands at top of beach, just behind shingle. At the west end there's what may have been a byre or store room, set back slightly from the front wall, measuring 2.5m x 1.5m. This may have extended to the back of the building, with an E-W division.
