Walls of a possible dwelling house which stands right on the beach. Entrance in south wall which trends 080deg. The entrance is nearer the west end, about 2/3 of the way along. Inside, there is evidence of a chimney or alcove at the west end.

At the east end there's a 7m x 4m walled area which might have been an enclosure, walls badly damaged. At the west end there is a store-room/bothy/byre 5m x 4m with a short wall protruding towards the beach from its entrance, protecting the door which is almost in the centre of the wall.
