<p>Type of site, description, dimensions, associated features etc</p> <p><b>Possible cairn or natural feature</b></p> <p>On a south facing steep slope a projecting mound which seen from either east or west has the classic profile of a cairn utilising the side of a hill. Across the top is a well established animal track revealing small and medium sized loose stones and what could be bedrock or well embedded orthostats. The feature is only 5.5m E-W but with the tumble down slope t is 9m N-S . The tumble also seems to incorporate outcrops of bedrock. There is not enough diagnostic evidence visible to allow a firm identification one way or the other but the site is included because of several other cairns within the vicinity.</p>		
<p>Context - surrounding terrain, proximity to water source, views from site etc</p> <p>Rough pasture among steep slopes and rocky outcrops north east of the head of the Cam Loch</p>
