## Abstract

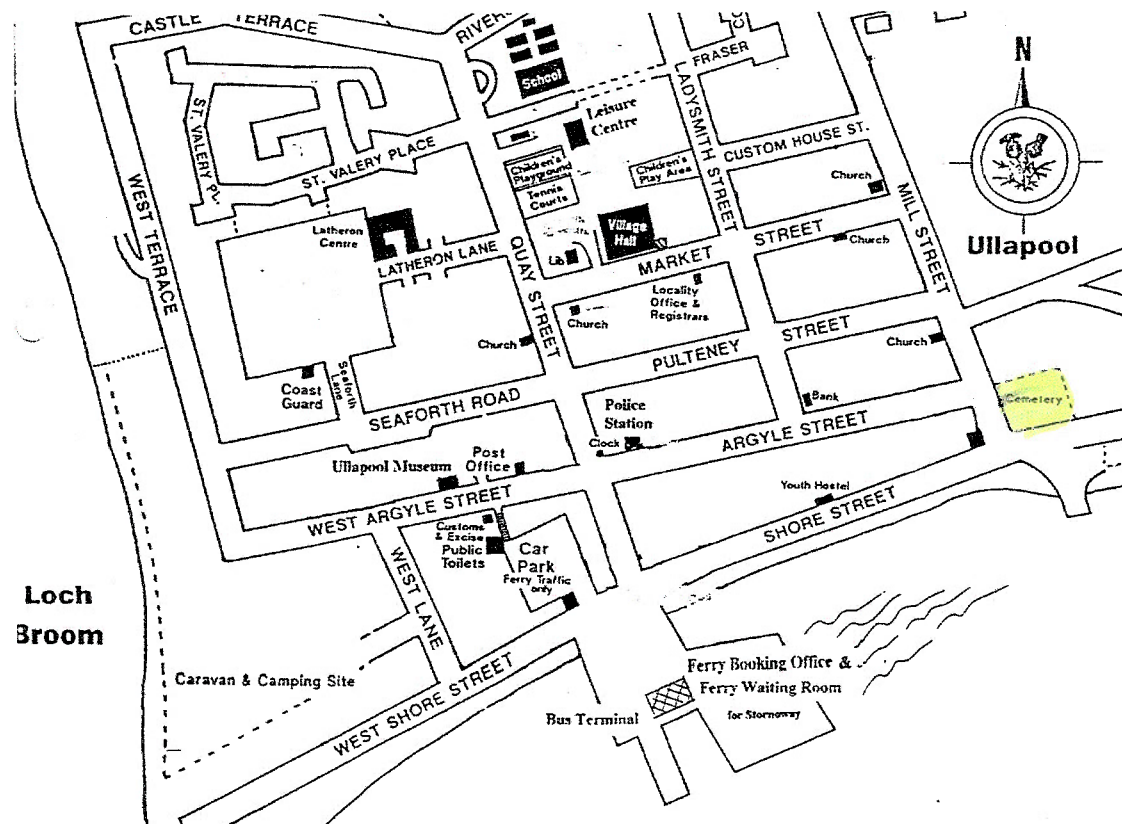

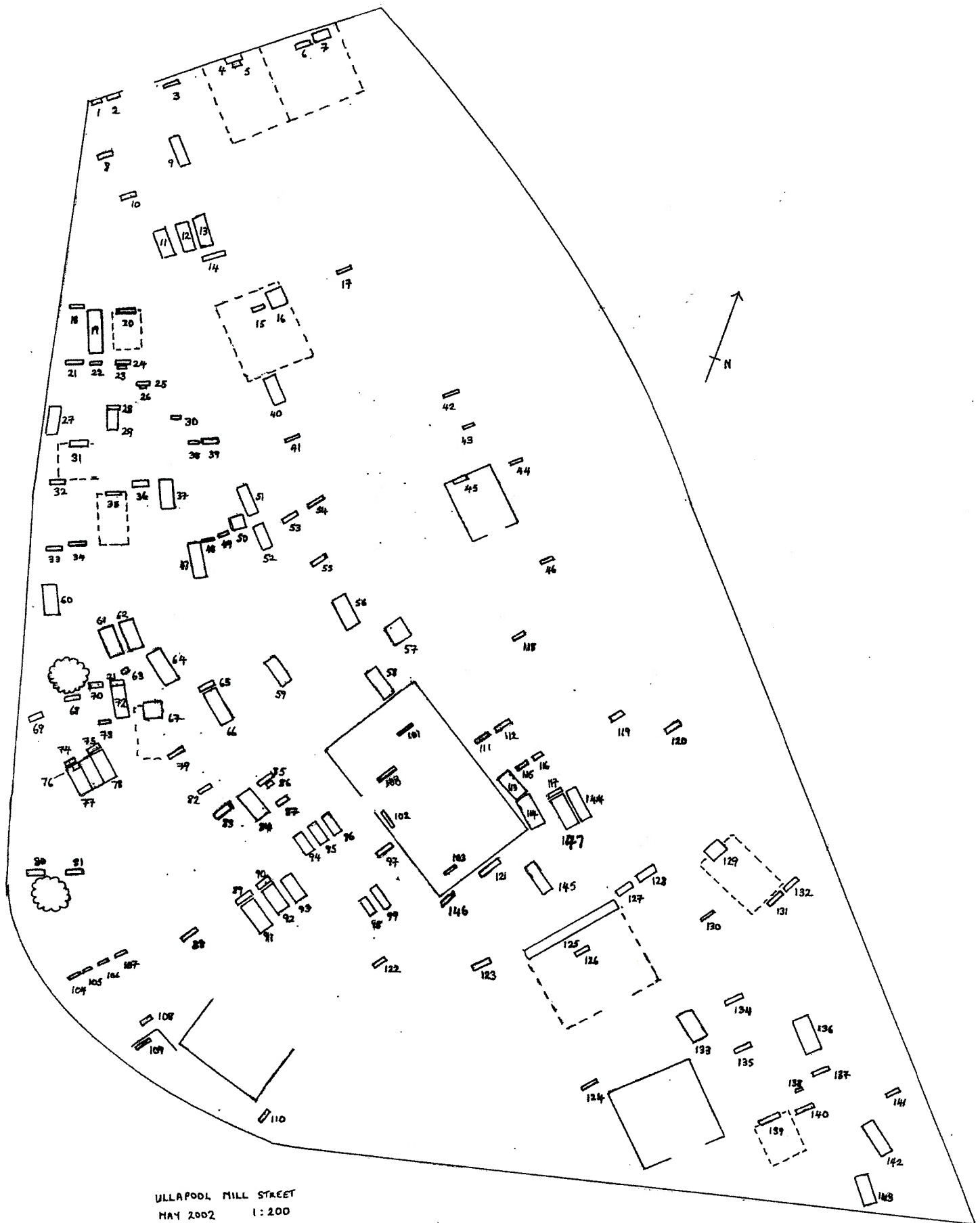

## **Introduction**

This burial ground is situated to the east end of the village of Ullapool. It served as the parish burial ground for over 200 years. Inhumations have taken place here from its earliest beginnings to the middle years of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

## **Site History**

Within the centre of the site stand the remains of a rectangular dry-stoned structure named as a chapel of uncertain origin. The building has a door to the south and a square niche on the inside of the north wall. Local tradition speaks of the building being used as an ammunition store by English soldiers during the 1745 Jacobite rising.

## **Ministers of the Church**

No former ministers of the parish are commemorated within the churchyard. Ministers of the parish of Lochbroom from 1569 to 1955 are as follows:

## **Date and condition of Monuments**

The memorials in the burial ground date from the late 18th century to the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. They are in a variety of styles including slabs, obelisks, pedestals, tablestones, headstones and Commonwealth War Graves. The vast majority is in a fair condition, only a few being damaged or broken. A number of slabs are partly visible under turf and were not included in the survey, as to uncover them would cause more damage, majority that are visible have no inscription and are only cover slabs.

## **Previous Work**

The burial ground has seen three previous surveys made of varying degrees.

Work in 1986 by Steven C Smyrl (Smyrl, 1986) noted the full/part inscription from 115 stones. He did uncover many stones from below the turf. No plan or photographs were made. Survey has shown that this document has a variety of errors. (See copy to rear)

Work in 1988 by C Rettie & K Skelton (Rettie & Skelton, 1988) made a note of 30 stones of a pre-1855 date noting most of the inscription and stone type. No plan or photographs were made. (See copy to rear)

Work in 1994 by R & R McMillan (McMillan, 1994) 96 stones were recorded noting complete inscription and compiling an alphabetical list of surnames by chronological date. No plan or photographs were made.

## **Church Records**

There are no records of deaths relating to the site, only those of births and marriages exist from the parish of Lochbroom. Records of burials also do not exist for the site.
