# CLACHAN CHURCHYARD A Survey of Its Memorials. NH 177/847

This survey was conducted as part of a project instigated by Ullapool Museum to survey a number of churchyards in the local area. This report gives details of inscriptions and an index of surnames, with an introduction to the site history.



#### Introduction

The church at Clachan is situated to the head of Loch Broom. It has served as the parish church for over 300 years. Inhumations have taken place here from its earliest beginnings and continue to the present day.

## **Church History**

The medieval church at Clachan was dedicated to St. Donan and belonged to the Cathedral of Ross. The parson, Mathew, is mentioned in a charter of 1227. The present church at Clachan was built in 1817. A possible foundation of an earlier church was found to the NW of the present church in 1962, but might have been part of a graveyard wall.

The Rev Roderick Macrae writing in the First Statistical Account (Sinclair, 1791-99) noted the stipend of the church to be 911 sterling with glebe of 301 and a large tract of ground worth 201, in all 1411 sterling a year. By the Second Statistical Account (NSA,1845) the Rev Thomas Ross noted the stipend to be '18 chalders, one-half barley, and one-half meal; the former, however being one thirty second part, and the latter, one-ninth part per boll, less than the county measure'.

The parish of Lochbroom united with Ullapool on the 11<sup>th</sup> September 1956 under the name of Lochbroom and Ullapool.

#### **Church Records**

There are no early records of deaths or burials; those of births and marriages exist in parts from 1798 to 1855 in the Old Parochial Registers. The Kirk of Session Records no longer exist; local tradition is of them being lost in a fire, though this could not be confirmed. No records exist in the Highland Council Archives. The only records in the National Archives of Scotland are the records of the Heritor's (HR/545) which comprise of :

#### **Church Fabric**

Built in 1817 and repaired in 1835 and 1878. The church is rectangular in plan with two tiers of windows and a round-arched door in the east gable. The belicote is possibly of remodeling of 1878.

# **Date and condition of Monuments**

The memorials in the churchyard date from the early 18th century to the modern day. They are in a variety of styles including slabs, obelisks, pedestals, tablestones and headstones. The vast majority is in good condition, only a few being damaged or broken. The churchyard is notable for containing the rectangular rubble-built enclosure of 1666 with a 19<sup>th</sup> century arched entrance. Enclosing monuments of the family of Mackenzie with the dates 1724 and 1732.

## **Future Work**

No study was made of the Heritor's Books with regard to the history of this site. A detailed study of these documents may give a better understanding of this site.

**Recording Form** 

For the purposes of this survey a recording form was devised based on that recommended by the Council for British Archaeology (Jones 1984). This form being quite detailed (see over), and possibly difficult to use, a simplified form detailing the most important points of recording was drawn up.(see over) This was to include the following:-

- 1. Full inscription, including all genealogical information.
- 2. Type and style of monument.
- 3. Orientation and size.
- 4. Material used.
- 5. Photograph: a colour print (4x5) for attachment to each recording form. Also that details of carvings or other comments could be recorded.

# **Key to Recording Form**

1st line - Date of Record - day upon record made;

- Recorder - initials of person making record;

- Memorial No. - number of stone relating to plan;

2nd line - Monument type - what kind of monument is it? Headstone/slab/etc;

3rd line - Material - What it is made of pink/yellow sandstone, granite, slate, etc;

4th line - Faces Inscribed (Compass Points) - What direction does the inscription face?


5th line - Condition of stone & inscription - overall is the stone and inscription together very good, good, very poor, or poor. Take into consideration the eligibility of the inscription and the stone itself;

6th line - Dimensions - use a handtape or extending ruler to measure size;

7th line - Remarks - describe anything of interest - carvings, condition in general. A sketch of any particular feature of the stone.


8th line - Inscription - record the complete inscription. Write each line as it is on the stone.


